Improve outcomes for all students through explicit, personalised teaching of reading and writing in the curriculum.

- Improve student outcomes for English from Prep to Year 6 to 100% achieving 'C' or above and 40% achieving an 'A' or 'B' by semester 2, 2019.
- Ensure 100% of students improve their A-E results through explicitly teaching reading and writing across the curriculum.

Our initiatives include

- Provide professional development and coaching for teacher and teacher aides to deepen knowledge and understanding of the Australian Curriculum and in particular English. (P-12 Curriculum, Assessment and Reporting Framework (CARF)) (Australian Institute for Teaching and School Leadership (AITSL) Coaching)
- Develop protocols for observation, coaching and feedback between teachers, teacher aides and principals at Cameron Downs and Prairie State Schools with a focus on reading and writing in the curriculum and K-2.
- Develop processes for a differentiated approach to teaching spelling, reading and writing within the curriculum. (P-12 CARF, Whole School Approach to Teaching Reading, Whole School Support for all Students)

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Purchasing additional teacher resources to: \$5,362
- Provide intensive and targeted teaching for students in Reading and Writing across P to 6.
- Purchasing replacement staff so that teachers/and or school principal can be released to observe, provide and or receive coaching and feedback in partnership with Cameron Downs State School in the area of Reading and Writing in the P-6 Curriculum.
- Purchase replacement staff so that teaching staff are able to attend professional development in the areas of reading and writing.
